ABOUT HIM



Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash, an eminent cardiologist of India, has served the nation tirelessly since 40 years. His unique strength lies in pioneering new life-saving models like Kalam-Raju Stent co-developed with his team for bridging accessibility and affordability of medical services for the poor while also mentoring thousands of next generation of doctors and public health workers, building a legacy. Dr. Surya Prakash through his rare combination of vision, leadership, and ground-level action, has not only treated 6,00,000+ patients but also redefined access and advancement of high-class healthcare in India through his skills and commitment.

He became a public healthcare leader by establishing 14 advanced heart care centers all over Central and South India under his spearheaded Care Hospitals along with his team, drastically improving healthcare accessibility and fortifying Indian medical infrastructure.

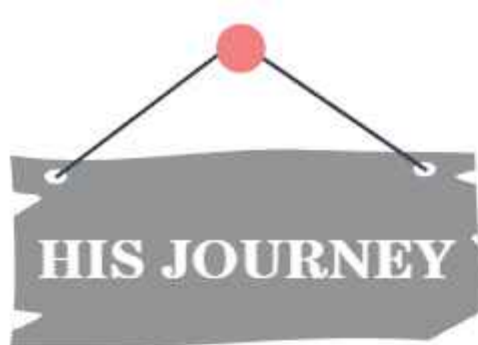
He is considered a prominent name in research and has published 70+ ground-breaking research papers and abstracts for The Indian Heart Journal, calling for medical reforms and also represented India in prominent countries like France, Sweden, Singapore, USA, Spain and Malaysia at conferences, seminars or to deliver lectures and workshops. He has been honoured by Society for Cardiovascular Angiography and Interventions (SCAI), USA as FSCAI. American College of Cardiology and European Society of Cardiology with FACC, FESC fellowships respectively. No doubt, his efforts have positioned India as the leader in global healthcare sector.

EARLY LIFE



Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash was born on 1st July, 1959 with a humble background, in the village of Ravupalli, Parvathipuram Manyam District which is economically and developmentally backward region of Andhra Pradesh. Growing up in a village with no high school, he moved to grand parents village Piridi for his 6th to 10th grade and later attended nearby town Bobbili for his 11th and 12th grades. It was during his intermediate that he first became aware of medical entrance exams. Moreover, motivated by his grandfather and seeing family under the grasp of poor health, he worked hard to get into MBBS in Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam in 1978. His dedication paid off when he secured the first rank in the medical entrance exam for postgraduate studies, getting into AIIMS, New Delhi for M.D (Medicine) in 1986. However, his highest education is accomplishing D.M (Cardiology) from Nizam Institute Of Medical Sciences (NIMS), Hyderabad in the year 1995, beginning his way towards abruptly transforming and uplifting healthcare sector in India.





Dr. Surya Prakash's journey from humble beginnings to becoming a senior consultant cardiologist at CARE Hospitals, Hyderabad, has been shaped by determination and overcoming numerous challenges. Back at his hometown Ravupalli, there was no education system at all as he completed his junior years studying under a tree, practicing letters on sands with fingers with no electricity. However, his stubbornness for education made him travel long distances, away from his family at mere age of 11.

After his completion of MBBS in 1983, he completed internship at King George Hospital, Vizag learning patient management. Further, completing his M.D (Medicine) in AIIMS in 1988, he joined the same institute as a senior resident in the Department of Medicine, also posted as an Emergency Medical Officer at the Emergency Department for an year, upgrading his emergency care skills and quick response. Later, he joined as Senior Resident in the Department of Cardiology worked as ICCU incharge, AIIMS for an year. Later worked as a senior resident at the Department of Cardiology in NIMS for an year then he got into DM (Cardiology) super speciality course in 1992 and completed DM in 1992-1995. Immediately he joined as an Assistant Professor of cardiology at the same Institute, serving until 1997, where he immensely improved his acquired skills and also developed unique methodologies to ease concepts for his students. Other than this, being member of CSI, IMA, IAG and attaining fellowships from abroad guided by Prof. Denton Cooley (Renowned Cardiac Surgeon from Texas) honed his skills in working up in cardiac transplant program and helped him bringing western and newer advancement to Indian stream in 2004.



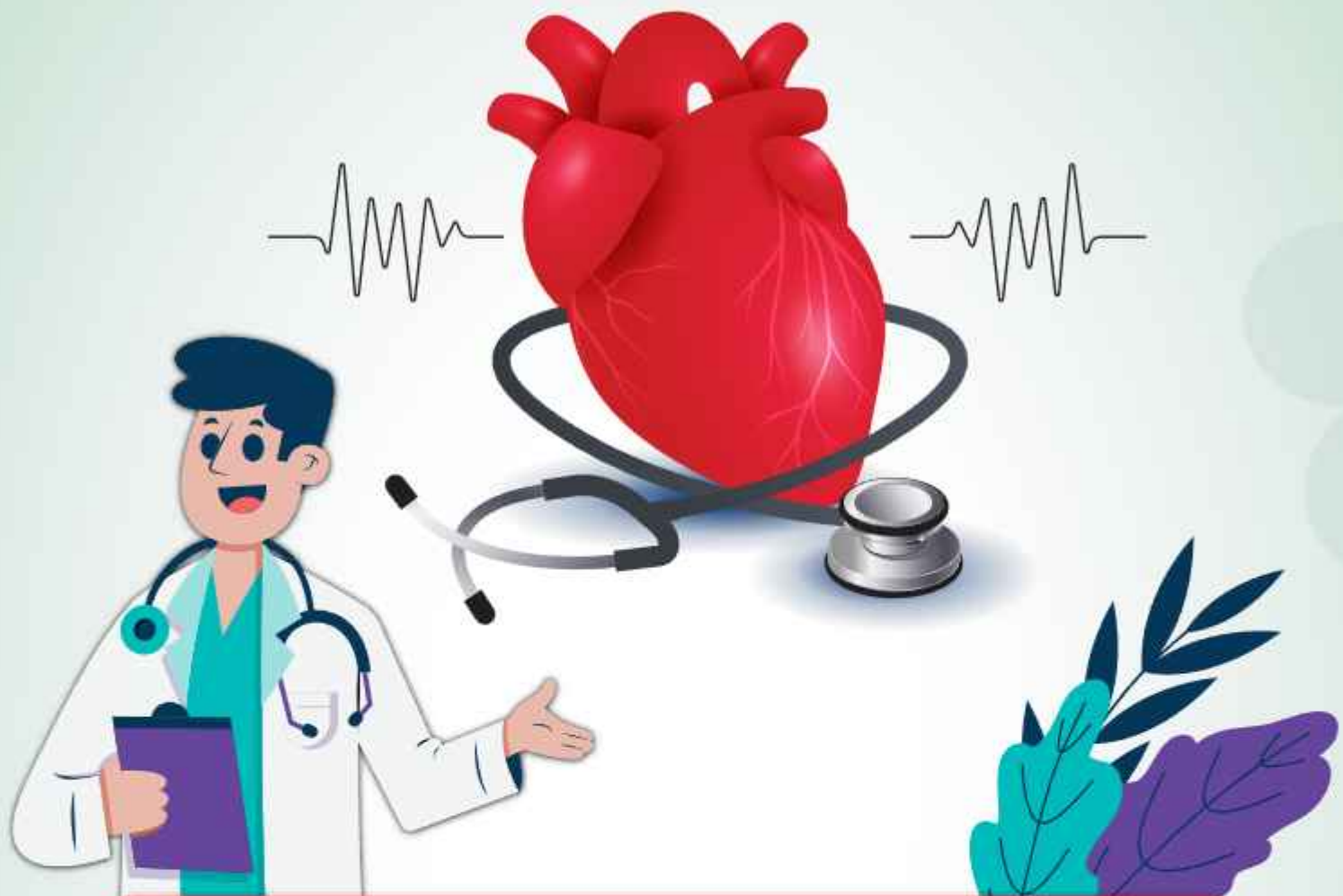
These skills helped him change the wellness landscape, where he left his subsequent job at Medicit Hospital to establish CARE Hospital with his NIMS colleagues in Hyderabad 1997, where he headed as Medical Superintendent (1998-2002), Medical Director of Secunderabad (2002-2019) and Musheerabad (2013 to 2019). He is currently designated as Regional Clinical Director Cardiology, CARE Hospitals, Hyderabad.

He stands out for his pioneering work in cardiology, particularly in introducing innovative treatments like catheter-based aortic valve replacements and co-developing the Kalam-Raju stent to reduce healthcare costs with his team. His leadership in establishing and expanding CARE Hospitals to 14 units, along with his extensive contributions to public health awareness and medical education, sets him apart.

Other than this, he has had a significant international impact through professional visits, conferences, and workshops in countries such as the USA, France, Spain, Sweden, Singapore, and Malaysia. His active participation in the world conference on TCT (Transcatheter Cardiovascular Therapeutics) and the American College of Cardiology's annual meetings highlights his global influence. He has also been honoured by the European Society of Cardiology with the FESC title in 2014 and has presented complex cases in Singapore, further showcasing his expertise on a global platform.

AS A CONSULTANT CARDIOLOGIST

- He actively involved as a team member in co-developing the famous Kalam-Raju stent in 1996, which significantly lowered the price to just ₹6000, was a game-changer in India's health-care system, offering a cost-effective solution for patients requiring coronary artery interventions. This included use of high-grade steel from missile technology.

- Established and rendered free cardiology services at Sri Sathya Sai Institute of Higher Medical Sciences (SSSIHMS) in Puttaparti (1992-93)
- Established various cardiac services, including a Cardiac ICCU with non-invasive services at Utkal Heart Centre, Bhubaneswar (1997)
- Established a four-bedded ICCU at Karshaka Maharshi Hospital in Parvatipuram (2001).
- Outpatient Services in Visakhapatnam – Since May 1997. Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash has been providing outpatient services in Visakhapatnam through dedicated two-day visits each month. These clinics have consistently ensured accessible, high-quality

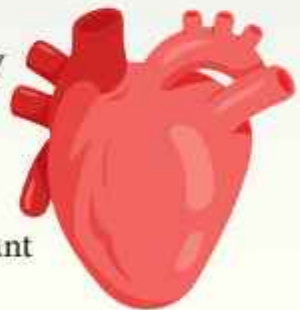
medical care for both rural and urban populations, addressing diverse health needs and significantly strengthening the region's healthcare outreach.

- VIMS: Initiated Outpatient Services (Since March 1998): Launched and have consistently managing monthly outpatient services at VIMS, held every 3rd Sunday since March 1998. These sessions serve over 1,000 patients each month, significantly

improving access to quality healthcare for underserved rural communities.

Pivotal Role in Establishing VIMS – Mother and Childcare Hospital: Played a key role in the establishment of the hospital by overseeing the selection of medical equipment and the complete setup of laboratory facilities. The hospital was inaugurated in

2008 by the former President of India, Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, marking a significant milestone in regional maternal and child healthcare.





Honorary Chairmanship and Mentorship by Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam: Following the inauguration, Dr. Kalam was honored by founder chairman Shri Viswayogi Viswamjee Maharaj as Honorary Chairman of VIMS.

Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam continued to provide guidance and inspiration to Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash, Executive Vice Chairman, VIMS offering his support and mentorship until his last breath.

- From 2002-2008, established ICCU setup and Non invasive cardiology setup (Echocardiography) at South Central Railway Hospital, Secunderabad.
- From 2015-18, Dr. Prakash established cardiology services at Andhra Mahila Sabha Hospital, Hyderabad, including outpatient, inpatient, intensive care, non-invasive (2D Echo, TMT), invasive services (CATH Lab), and a Cardiac Surgery department.
- Motivated by the visionary ideals of Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash initiated the Janma Bhoomi project in Bobbili in 2017, which remains active to this day. Through monthly two-day visits to the Bobbili center, he has ensured the

accessibility and availability of both preventive and advanced cardiac care to rural populations. This initiative stands as a testament to his unwavering commitment to bridging the urban-rural healthcare divide and fostering long-term community well-being.

- Served as the Honorary Consultant Cardiologist to notable personalities including his Excellency Sri PV Narasimha Rao, Prime Minister of India (1992-97), and his Excellency Sri Krishna Kant, Governor of Andhra Pradesh (1992-97).
- He was also the Honorary Consultant and in-charge of the Cardiology unit at South Central Railway Hospital, Secunderabad (2002-07)
- He was also the Honorary Consultant ESI Hospital, Secunderabad (2007-08)



AS AN EDUCATIONIST



FOR MEDICAL STUDENTS:

- At AIIMS, New Delhi from 1986-1990, taught 250+ Undergraduate, Postgraduate, Post-MD/MS registrars of Medicine, Cardiology and Surgery, posted as a senior resident and in-charge of causality services.
- At NIMS, Hyderabad, mentored Postgraduate students of medicine from 1991-1995. Later joining as an Assistant Professor, taught and guided the PG students in their thesis and research projects from 1995-1997.
- As a Senior Consultant Cardiologist involved in teaching DNB Cardiology Fellows and also training them in Non-Invasive and Invasive Cardiology from 1997 to till date. Mentored about 70 students of Postgraduate Diploma in Community Cardiology (PGDCC) both in clinical and practical aspects during 2006-2012.
- Trained numerous medical professionals for PG or SS Entrances- 42 Post MD candidates secure seats in DM Cardiology programs across India (1991-97) at NIMS, Hyderabad, also guiding around 50 candidates to gain admission into various postgraduate courses worldwide while working at CARE Hospitals, Secunderabad (1998-2014).





WORKSHOP CONDUCTED:

- Actively participated in numerous workshops, such as the "Percutaneous Balloon Mitral Valvuloplasty Follow-up Study Workshop", "ASD & PDA Closure Workshop" and the "Peripheral Angioplasty & Stenting Workshop" with key cardiologists from France and USA. He was a key resource person in workshops at Charles Nicole Hospital, France (1996) and participated in state-level workshops on managing cardiovascular diseases in collaboration with Kasturba Gandhi College and the Indian Dietetic Association.
- Delivered numerous lectures including topics like "Challenges of Angioplasty in Indian Population" at the 13th North America Telugu Conference (Philadelphia, 2001), "Management of Acute Myocardial Infarction" in Parvatipuram (2001), and "Heart Diseases in India, The Next Epidemic" at Kasturba Gandhi Degree College (2013).





FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AWARENESS:

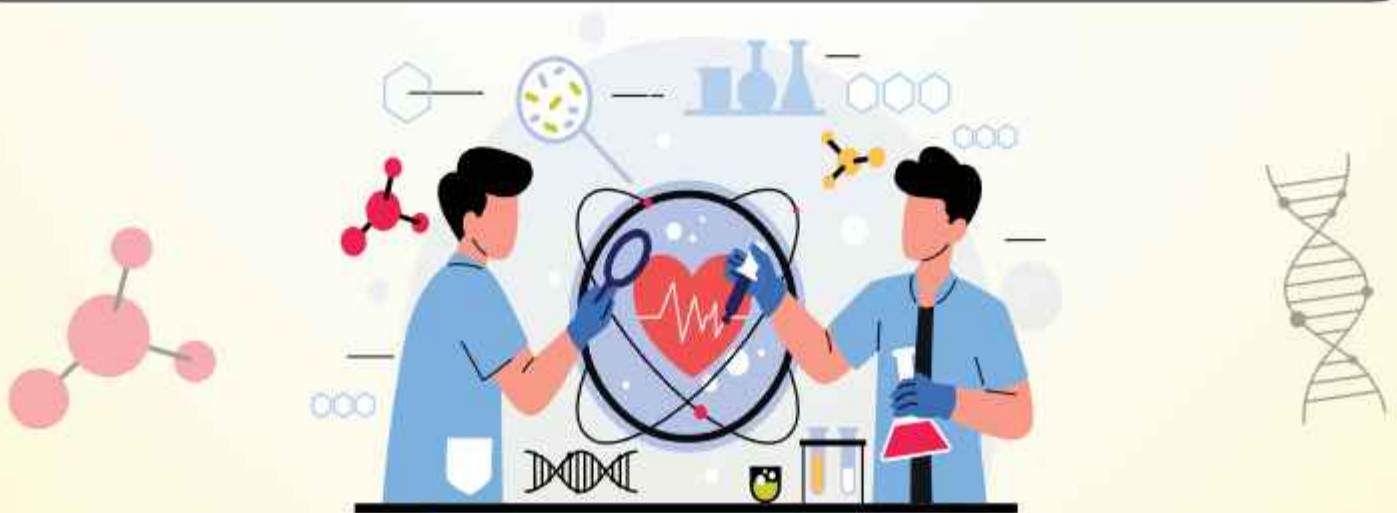
- Addressed medical students, professionals, and the public on topics such as hypertension, cardiac rehabilitation, and healthy living, in various institutions like MOLDTEK Industries, ESI Medical College, and Bharat Dynamics Ltd, impacting communities and inspiring future medical professionals.
- Head of Cardiac Rehabilitation at Care Hospitals for 8 years, focusing on post-procedure care, Preventive and lifestyle improvements- conducting yoga and awareness sessions.
- Contributed extensively as an educator through various media platforms and TV appearances on Doordarshan and other channels, where he answered public queries on heart diseases, notably with TV5. He also participated in radio programs, including a Q&A on lifestyle and cardiac problems in Dallas, Texas, USA in 2010, as well as three radio programs on hypertension and cardiovascular diseases with All India Radio (AIR).





AS RESEARCHER:

- Till date, 70+ research papers and abstracts are named after him, primarily focusing on Preventive Cardiology, Hypertension, Heart failure and Interventional Cardiology. Also presented at the TCT 2019 in San Francisco, showcasing a challenging interventional case and participated as a panelist in the "Coronary Complications" session.
- Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash has contributed to over 18 major clinical and academic studies, spanning from his MD thesis on bronchial asthma to cutting-edge global trials on heart failure, diabetes, and anticoagulation.
- He actively participated in landmark trials such as EXTRACT-TIMI 25, POLYCAP, IMPROVE-IT, THE BALANCE and ODYSSEY Outcomes, bringing advanced cardiovascular research to Indian institutions.
- Notably, he also established a Heart Failure Registry under the "Smiling Hearts" initiative, enrolling over 1,600 patients for long-term follow-up and improving chronic care outcomes.



ESTABLISHMENT AND EXPANSION OF CARE HOSPITALS

In 1997, Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash co-founded CARE Hospitals alongside his colleagues from NIMS, establishing it as a premier healthcare institution in India. When the organisation faced a leadership crisis following the resignation of its chairpersons, Dr. Surya

Prakash remained steadfast. Demonstrating unwavering dedication, he took charge of expanding CARE's mission across the country—ensuring continuity of care, reinforcing institutional strength, and upholding the founding vision of making quality healthcare

accessible and affordable to the needy.

- Established and headed Non-invasive Cardiology Services with Critical Care support at CARE Hospitals, Secunderabad (1998) and maintained it until now.

- Leadership at the Cardiac Rehabilitation Centre, CARE Hospitals (2007–2019). As Head of the Department at the Cardiac Rehabilitation Centre at CARE Hospitals' Nampally unit (2007–2019), Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash played a pivotal role in supporting

the recovery and well-being of over 18,000 cardiac patients, providing comprehensive rehabilitation services to those recovering from heart-related illnesses.

- Established a 100-bed CARE Hospitals facility in Visakhapatnam in 1999, pioneering advanced healthcare services, particularly in cardiology—in a region that never had such facilities for many decades, and setting a benchmark in medical care across Coastal Andhra

Pradesh.

- Played a pivotal role in the Renal Transplantation Unit setup at Care Hospital, Musheerabad (2013), acquiring all necessary legal and ethical permissions from the Transplant Authority of India.
- Led the establishment of Advanced Cardiac Cath Lab Facility (GE INNOVA 2100 OPTIMA Edition) with advanced features at CARE Hospitals, Musheerabad (2014)
- Established Daycare Dialysis Units (3 centers) with cost-effective services at CARE Secunderabad Unit (2015).
- Revived Musheerabad CARE Hospital as Medical Director in 2013, transforming it into the Best Performing Unit by 2015. Additionally, established a 6-bedded Step-Down Intensive CARE Unit at the same unit (2015).
- Established a 12-bedded MICU and 11-bedded ICCU at CARE Hospitals, Musheerabad and Secunderabad (2017).



LEADERSHIP ROLES AND COMMITTEES AT CARE HOSPITALS (2013-2019):

- Held various leadership positions, including Chairman of the Administrative Quality Assurance, Drug Therapeutic, Medical Records, Patient Quality Assurance, Internal Grievance, Mortality and Morbidity, Diagnostics Quality Assurance, Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation, and Clinical Audit Committees, contributing significantly to hospital governance and quality management.
- Served as a Committee Member for CARE Hospital Employees Welfare Association (2001-2004), Member of the CARE Foundation (2012-2020), and Advisory Board Member for multiple hypertension symposia.



OTHER SOCIAL WORKS

- **Regular Free Medical Camps in Multiple Regions (1986-2025):** Organised numerous free medical camps across South Delhi, Parvatipuram, Bobbili, Karimnagar, Srikakulam, and Charla village. These camps provided free consultations, ECGs, 2D Echos, and medications, benefiting lakhs of patients, especially focusing on senior citizens, cardiac issues, and basic health screenings. Support for School Children in South Delhi through Free Medical Camps: Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash conducted free medical camps specifically for school-going children, focusing on early detection of health issues. Children identified as needing further evaluation or treatment were brought to AIIMS, New Delhi, where care was arranged completely free of cost, ensuring that financial barriers did not hinder access to essential medical support.
- **Ongoing Initiatives at Viswayogi Institute of Medical Sciences (1998-Present):** Established and continues to organise a multi-specialty free medical camp every third Sunday at Viswayogi Institute of Medical Sciences, Viswanagar, benefiting around 1,000 patients per session with free consultations, tests, and medicines.
- **Mega Medical Camps and Special Events (2001-2025):** Coordinated large-scale free health camps, including a two-day camp in Srikakulam (2001), a mega multi-specialty camp in Chandragiri (2007), and a cardiac screening camp on World Heart Day (2011). These camps provided vital healthcare services to underserved communities and rural areas, including screening tests and health education.

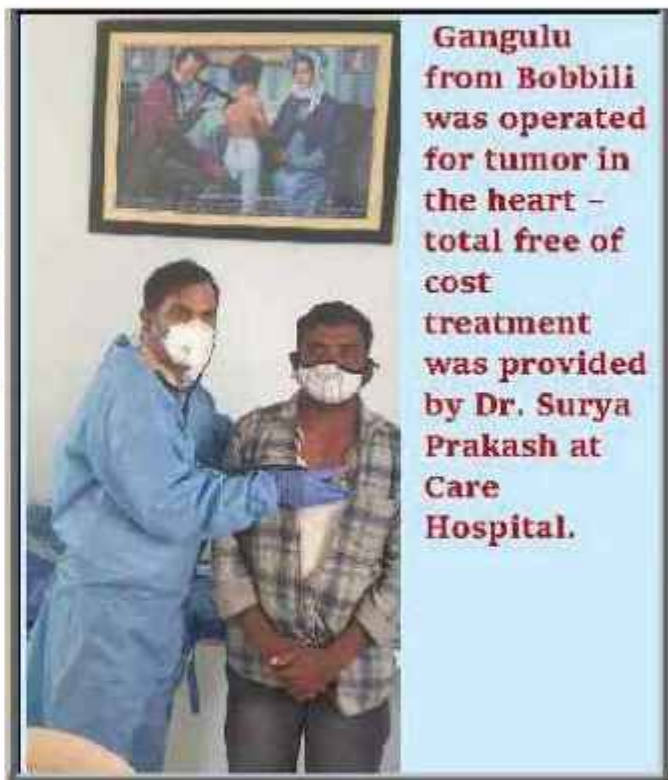

- **Increasing Indian Healthcare Standards:** India's regional healthcare units faced difficulties in meeting global standards due to unskilled workforce and uncertain administration. However, his contributions towards best clinical and patient care practices, inspired ground-level change in medical sector of India.



- **Uplifting Future Healthcare Providers:** There was a lack of formal training for younger medical professionals in advanced techniques and compassionate care due to curriculum limitations. Determined, Dr.Suryaprakash has trained 10,000+ medical professionals through workshops, seminars, and hands-on training sessions since 2005, laying the foundation for a future generation of well-trained healthcare providers. He also inspired them to adopt a community-focused, compassionate approach to medicine, emphasizing giving back to society.





IMPACT OF HIS WORK ON SOCIETY AT LARGE

- **Development of Cost-Effective Healthcare Approach:** Back in 2000s, medical expenses were costly due to limited availability or import charges. But his co-development of the Kalam-Raju stent, reduced stent costs by 70%, creating it a gold-standard resource used nation-wide. This gifted millions of people, a gift of new life.
- **Increasing Healthcare Accessibility through Free Medical Camps in Underserved Areas** Recognizing that both rural and urban underserved communities often face barriers to healthcare access, Dr. Gulla Surya Prakash has worked tirelessly to bridge this gap. Through regular free medical camps, he has provided essential services including consultations, diagnostics, and medications. By 2025, he had organized over 400 medical camps, directly benefiting more than 6,00,000 residents across rural and urban areas, significantly enhancing accessibility to quality healthcare.
- **Strengthening the Bond Between People and Healthcare:** The healthcare system was often viewed as distant and many felt that it was difficult to access quality care. But his community outreach programs broke down barriers, ensuring that healthcare is seen as a fundamental right rather than a privilege.
